Advancing the Common Good

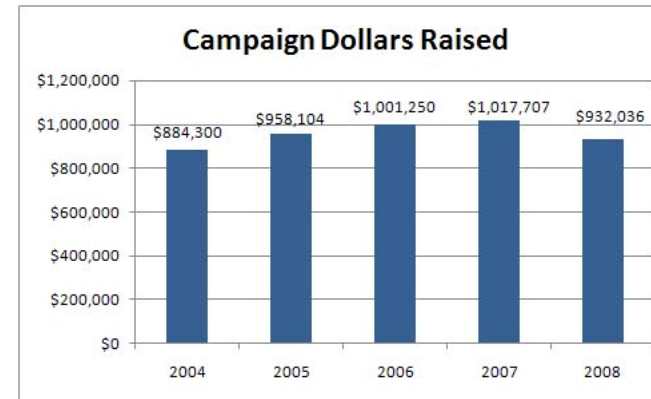
- United Way is a community change agent focused on providing everyone in the community the building blocks to a good life by focusing on education, income and health services.
