



Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Grand Prize?

The 2010 Grand Prize is your choice between the Wisconsin Homes Cambridge 1615 home and \$50,000 OR \$100,000.

New this year, there will be 2nd (\$4,000) and 3rd (\$1,000) prizes awarded.

How can I enter?

You can enter to win by purchasing a ticket for \$60 or two tickets for \$100.

Tickets are for sale at ticket locations only. No phone, online or mail-in sales allowed.

You can also purchase tickets at Open Houses held select Saturdays during the raffle. See www.marshfieldareaunitedway.org for locations and Open House dates.

How many tickets are available?

5,000 are available.

Is there a limit on how many tickets I can buy?

No, there is no limit on number of tickets you can purchase.

What are the odds of winning?

The odds of winning the grand prize if you only bought 1 ticket are 1 in 5,000 if all tickets are sold. Your odds of winning increases for each ticket bought.

When is the drawing going to be held?

Thursday, April 29 at 12:30 p.m. on location at Wisconsin Homes, 425 West McMillan, Marshfield WI.

Who draws the winning ticket?

The winning ticket will be drawn by a representative of Marshfield Area United Way.

Do I have to be present to win?

No, you do not have to be present to win. We will notify the winner within 24 hours after the drawing.

What happens if you don't reach the minimum tickets sold?

If 4,300 are not sold, a 50/50 drawing will be held. 50 percent of the proceeds going to the winner and the other 50 percent to Marshfield Area United Way.

How much are Taxes?
