ALICE, an acronym which stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed, is a way of defining our families, neighbors, and colleagues who work hard, earn above the federal poverty level, but not enough to afford the basics where they

live. ALICE households and households in poverty are forced to make tough choices, such as deciding between quality child care or paying the rent choices that have long-term consequences not only for their families, but for all. In 2023, the most recent ALICE report was released. Here is some of the data reported and how your support of United Way is working to ensure everyone as the opportunity to thrive.
