

LOCAL IMPACT STORY

Taylor had been having a tough time in a couple of her classes, and it was starting to wear on her confidence. Her parents could see she was getting discouraged and unsure of herself. Wanting to turn things around, they reached out to Spencer Kids Group to see if there was any extra support available.

The response was immediate and thoughtful. Instead of adding more pressure, the team focused on creating a calm, encouraging space where Taylor could feel safe to ask questions and take her time. That shift made all the difference.

Within just a few weeks, Taylor's progress report showed significant improvement. But even more meaningful than the grades was the change in her attitude. She started completing assignments on her own, speaking up when she didn't understand something, and even offering help to her classmates.

Her parents were overjoyed—not just by her academic progress, but by how much more confident and motivated she had become. Thanks to Spencer Kids Group and United Way, Taylor wasn't just catching up—she was thriving.

LOCAL IMPACT STORY



For a time, John was living out of his van in a parking lot south of Marshfield with no basic amenities and only his small dog for company. Life was difficult, and he was struggling to find a way back to stable housing. A concerned local resident noticed his situation and called North Central Community Action Program after being referred by United Way's 211.

Shortly after, a case manager from NCCAP visited John, assessed his needs, and helped him access essential resources like food and clothing while working on securing permanent housing. Together, they found a room he could rent, and the case manager coordinated with the landlord to help John with

the first month's rent.

To make sure he could maintain his new home, the case manager also helped John set up automatic rent payments, and connected him with other community agencies for additional support. Thanks to this assistance and United Way, John now lives comfortably and is steadily rebuilding his life.

LOCAL IMPACT STORY

Evelyn is turning 95 soon. She spent the past five years caring for her significant other. During that time, the daily demands of looking after both him and herself wore her down. Home Delivered Meals was there to help when she needed it most. This program became a vital support for her, providing dietetically specialized meals that met her partner's unique needs as well as her own, so she didn't have to prepare separate meals for both of them and she could focus on providing the loving care her partner needed.



Evelyn's partner passed away six months ago, but thanks to the ongoing help from Home Delivered Meals and United Way, she has been able to regain her strength. She continues to live independently in her own home, with daily check-ins from the meal delivery drivers, who provide both nourishing meals and companionship.
